As Chair of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) and on behalf of its Member States, it is my distinct honor to convey our congratulations to the Government and People of the Republic of India on the occasion of the 25th Anniversary of the establishment of ASEAN-India Dialogue Relations.

Since the forging of ASEAN-India sectoral dialogue partnership on 28 January 1992, we have elevated the relationship to a strategic level, partnering in groundbreaking initiatives across political-security, economic, and socio-cultural pillars for mutual benefit. In the last 25 years, ASEAN-India Dialogue Relations have contributed to the maintenance of peace, stability, and prosperity in the region.

ASEAN and India have further strengthened their cooperation, partnership and mutual trust through India's active involvement in various ASEAN led mechanisms, including the ASEAN-India Summit, East Asia Summit (EAS), ASEAN-India Post Ministerial Conference (PMC), ASEAN Regional Forum (ARF), and other senior official meetings and engagements. We also appreciate India's commitment of a USD 1 billion line of credit for ASEAN Connectivity projects and await the development of modalities for utilizing this mechanism. We welcome India's support for ASEAN's efforts in narrowing development gaps between and within ASEAN Member States through various capacity building programmes under the Initiative for ASEAN Integration (IAI), and look forward to India's continued commitment in this regard.

We laud India's commitment to strengthen ASEAN-India people to people ties through the annual Delhi Dialogue; ASEAN-India Student Exchange Programmes; Indian scholarship programmes for ASEAN students; Special Course for ASEAN Diplomats; ASEAN-India Young Farmers Exchange Programme; ASEAN-India Media Exchange Programme; and the ASEAN-India Network of Think Tanks. We appreciate India's support for the establishment and early operationalization of the ASEAN-India Center to further strengthen cooperation.

ASEAN welcomes a more productive partnership with India in years to come, cognizant of its historical and cultural ties with ASEAN Member States, and its growing contribution to the fulfillment of our common goal of peace, security, progress, and shared prosperity.
