Ministry of Foreign Affairs Turkmenistan in association with the Embassy of India, Ashgabat, and Chess Federation of Turkmenistan organized an International Chess Tournament for diplomats and their families at the Chess and Checkers School, Ashgabat from July 15-16, 2022. The event was organized as a prelude to the 44th FIDE Chess Olympiad 2022 & FIDE Congress to be hosted by India from 28th July-10th August, 2022 in Chennai.

The tournament was opened on July 15, 2022 with welcome address by Dr. Vidhu P. Nair, Ambassador of India to Turkmenistan, followed by remarks from H.E.
