University of Petra, (UoP) (www.uop.edu.jo), Amman Jordan and Amity University Uttar Pradesh (AUUP) (www.amity.edu) have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) which sets out the role of both the Universities and how they will work together in the future to achieve their goals. Under this MoU the two institutions would proceed to implement cooperation and exchange in all academic areas of mutual interest and would also expand the basis for friendship and educational exchange between India and Jordan. The MoU will remain in effect for a period of five years.

The two institutions have agreed on development of collaborative teaching and research projects; exchange of students, research and teaching personnel and organization of scientific research and related activities.

Both UoP and AUUP are private and prestigious educational institutions offering programmes in business administration, finance and banking, marketing, management, information systems and IT resources management for both private and public sectors. Petra University has six Professors with Indian background. Currently about 500 Jordanians are studying in India. Over 2500 alumni, who graduated from India, are well placed across the spectrum and act as promoting agents of Indo-Jordanian relations.

Cooperation in education sector for empowering the youth is a major priority for both the countries and it is expected that such collaborative efforts will greatly contribute to this goal.
