Monuments of India exhibition launched in Tunis on 1st October, 2015



An exhibition titled **Monuments of India** was jointly inaugurated by H.E. Mrs. Latifa Lakhdhar, Minister for Culture of Government of Tunisia and H.E. Mrs. Nagma M. Mallick, Ambassador of India in Tunisia on 1st October, 2015. The exhibition united two exhibitions: a set of watercolours depicting the monuments of India through the ages beginning from Mohenjo Daro, the Buddhist Stupas of Sanchi and Ellora, the temples of Mahabalipuram, Konarak and Khajuraho through the European-influenced imperial architecture of the colonial period to the buildings of contemporary India. A second collection featured photographs of Islamic Monuments of India of the Delhi Sultanate and the Mughal period. Many Tunisians and mediapersons attended the inauguration.

2. The exhibition at Maison des Arts, Tunis, will be open to the public for 7 days, after which it will be exhibited in other cities of Tunisia.

3. The exhibition is jointly organized by the Ministry of Culture of the Government of the Republic of Tunisia and the Embassy of India in Tunis under the bilateral Cultural Exchange Programme.
