Farewell Call by the Indian Ambassador on the Vice President of Indonesia

The Ambassador of India to Indonesia and Timor Leste H.E. Mr. Gurjit Singh paid a farewell call on the Hon'ble Vice President of Indonesia H.E. Mr. Jusuf Kalla on 18 December 2015.
