

Bilateral Meeting between leaders of India and Angola (26 July 2018)

[on the sidelines of BRICS Summit in Johannesburg]

Shri Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Prime Minister of India had a bilateral meeting with Mr Joao Lourenco, Hon'ble President of Angola on the sidelines of the BRICS Summit in Johannesburg, South Africa, on 26 July 2018.

The two leaders discussed ways to intensify bilateral relations in trade & investment, agriculture & food processing, pharmaceuticals and healthcare and oil & natural gas. In a tweet after the meeting, Prime Minister Modi described his interaction with President João Lourenço as "comprehensive", while adding that "Angola is a valued friend from Africa. We discussed ways to deepen bilateral cooperation, particularly trade as well as people-to-people ties".
