Visit of the All-Party Delegation to the Republic of Libera (May 31-June2, 2025)

The All-Party Parliamentary Delegation from India, led by Hon'ble Member of Parliament Dr. Shrikant Eknath Shinde, is visiting Liberia from May 31-June 2, 2025 as part of India's global outreach to underscore its message of 'Zero Tolerance Against Terrorism'.

2. The delegation was received on their arrival in Monrovia on the evening of 31 May by Mr. Manoj Bihari Verma, Ambassador of India to Liberia, H.E. Sekou S. Kanneh, Representative and Chairman of the Executive Committee, H.E. Prince A Toles, Representative, House of Representatives of Liberia and members of Indian community in Liberia. The warm reception and high-level presence reflected Liberia's strong solidarity with India - particularly in the wake of the cowardly terrorist attack in Pahalgam, Jammu & Kashmir, India.

3. On 1st June, the delegation paid solemn floral tributes at the grave of former President William V.S. Tubman, fondly remembered as the 'Father of Modern Liberia', at the National Museum of Liberia. The visit to the National Museum, which is a powerful symbol of resilience and rich heritage of Liberia, reaffirmed India's solidarity with the people of Liberia and India's firm commitment to uphold peace and security globally.

4. Later in the day, the delegation interacted with members of the Indian community in Liberia. The delegation members conveyed the collective will of India to fight terrorism in all its forms and manifestations and the support received from the international community in this endeavor. They also appreciated the Diaspora's role in strengthening India's friendship with Liberia.
