Visit of the All-Party Delegation from India to New York

- The All-Party Delegation from India, led by Hon'ble Member of Parliament Dr. Shashi Tharoor, arrived in New York as part of a diplomatic outreach aimed at projecting India's united and resolute stance against terrorism in all its forms and manifestations. Other members of the delegation include Shri Bhubaneswar Kalita, Member of Parliament (Rajya Sabha), Shri Milind Murli Deora, Member of Parliament (Rajya Sabha), Shri Shashank Mani Tripathi, Member of Parliament (Lok Sabha), Shri Ganti Harish Madhur, Member of Parliament (Lok Sabha) and Amb.
