

**Information on Continuation of Education in Moldova for Indian medical students evacuated from Ukraine**

- i. In accordance with the Ordinance No.177 of 15.03.2022 issued by the Moldovan Ministry of Education and Research, the universities can temporary accept displaced students from Ukrainian universities as part of academic mobility programs till the end of the current semester.
- ii. NTSUMP may accept medical students for permanent transfer, starting with the academic year 2022-23. Students should apply for transfer as soon as they will receive the academic certificates confirming the completion of the current academic year, as well as all the documents required for registration in the Republic of Moldova.
- iii. University can accept up to 200 students at the faculties of Medicine, Dentistry and Pharmacy. The medium of instruction is English. The University will accept transfers to the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> years of study, after examination of the submitted records (academic certificates). The curricula should match a minimum of 70%. In case the curricula do not meet the requirements, the University can recommend to repeat the last year.
- iv. Enrolled students have to pay the tuition fee according to the individual agreement signed between the student and the University. The tuition fee for the next academic year (English medium) for Faculty of Medicine is 5000 Euro per year, Dentistry – 6000 Euro per year and Pharmacy – 4500 Euro per year. The tuition fee is to be paid in a single installment. The tuition fee does not include registration in the Republic of Moldova, hostel accommodation, travel expenses, etc.
- v. The University may offer hostel accommodation for an extra cost, depending on the availability of seats.
