Applications from eligible persecuted religious minority migrants from Bangladesh and Pakistan based in India for nominations to **undergraduate B.E./B.Pharmacy/MBBS /BDS courses** under Self-Financing Scheme for the academic year 2019-20 against seats to be granted by Ministry of Human Resource Development and Ministry of Health & Family Welfare respectively to Ministry of External Affairs may be forwarded to Ministry of External Affairs, US (Education) **latest by 30.06.2019**
- 3. Kindly note that all applicants are required to appear in National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) conducted by National Testing Agency for admission in MBBS/BDS UG courses in India as per NTA notification dated 03.11.2018 on NEET. For more information log on to: www.ntaneet.nic.in. The candidates will be selected on the basis of following eligibility criterion by Students Cell.

4. Eligibility Criteria

(I). For admission to MBBS /BDS

- (a) A candidate must have scored a minimum of 50% marks each in Physics, Chemistry and Biology and 50% in English in the qualifying examination (equivalent to 10+2 standard of CBSE in India; equivalence certificate from Association of Indian Universities must be enclosed if applicable).
- (b) NEET- It shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of marks at 50th percentile in NEET.

(II). For admission to B.E./ B.Tech

A candidate must have scored a minimum of 60% marks each in Physics, Chemistry and Maths and 50% in English in the qualifying examination

(equivalent to 10+2 standard of CBSE in India; equivalence certificate from Association of Indian Universities must be enclosed if applicable).

(III). For admission to B.Pharmacy

A candidate must have scored a minimum of 60% marks each in Physics, Chemistry and Biology and 50% in English in the qualifying examination (equivalent to 10+2 standard of CBSE in India; equivalence certificate from Association of Indian Universities must be enclosed if applicable).

- (IV). The candidates applying for B. Arch course are required to pass the Aptitude Test as prescribed by Council of Architecture. The candidates who do not pass the Aptitude Test will not be eligible for award of enrollment by Council of Architecture, New Delhi.
- (V). Where grades are awarded in grade XII or equivalent exam, the marks obtained in percentage terms should invariably be indicated along with the criteria for converting the relevant grades into percentage.

- 6. Applicants should enclose the following with their applications:-
- a. three copies of recent passport size photograph,
- b. copy of Foreign passport current or last held,
- c. copy of Entry Visa into India,
- d. copy of long Term Visa,
- e. copy of last FRRO/FRO registration (proof of last police reporting in case of Pakistani nationals),
- f. copy of birth certificate,
- g. character certificate from Head of the Institution last attended,
- h. copies of marks sheets of grade XII or equivalent exam,
- i NEET score,
- j. In case the applicant has passed the qualifying exam from a foreign country, the marks sheet and degree / certificate of the qualifying exam are required to be attested by the concerned Indian Mission in that country.

- 7. All the documents as mentioned in para 6(a) to (h) should be duly attested by FRO / Gazetted officers of concerned district administration. I.
- 8. The applicants may please be advised that merely forwarding their applications should not be treated as assurance for their nomination by the Ministry. The Ministry will scrutinize all the applications and only after these are found complete in all respects, the names of the eligible applicants will be considered for nomination in the order of merit and preference for the course.
- 9. Selected candidates are expected to comply with admission formalities, fee structures and procedures of the respective college / university.
- 10. The list of colleges / institutions for MBBS / BDS courses (as per last year's allocation) is enclosed. The seats are generally allocated in these Colleges / Institutions but may vary depending on the final allocation by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare. Applicants may accordingly indicate their preference for the institute and the course.
- 11. The list of colleges / institutions for BE/ B.Pharmacy courses where Ministry of Human Resource Development has allotted seats in academic year 2019-20 is enclosed. Applicants may accordingly indicate their preference for the institute and the course.
